- New ADA Ramps
- Sidewalk Gaps
- Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs)
- Restriping (including road diets, adding bike lanes, and other related projects)
- Construction Ready Projects

MAY CONSIDERATION DEADLINE April 26, 2024

Criteria

Agencies must:

- Submit early opportunity application, vicinity map, and estimated cost of project.
- Meet important dates to be considered.
- Complete projects in 2024.
